Interventional Radiology, Baystate Medical Center, Springfield, MA March 27, 2023 - April 21, 2023

• Reviewed imaging to determine whether procedures could be done safely and the best approach to take. Used ultrasound guidance to perform numerous procedures including diagnostic and therapeutic thoracentesis and paracentesis, chest tube placement, thyroid nodule biopsies, liver biopsies, fat pad biopsies, and lymph node biopsies. Assisted with porta-catheter removals and closing of the pocket after port removal. Assisted with

gastrostomy tube replacements under fluoroscopy. Removed Permacaths. Observed a Y-90 (radioembolization) procedure.

Provided cross coverage at night. Conducted complete history and physical exams on patients who presented to the ED and decided whether ICU admission was appropriate. Wrote admission notes. Carried out many procedures, including emergent endotracheal intubation, central and arterial line placements, ultrasound-guided IVs, rapid rhino insertion, foley catheter placement, aspiration of knee bursitis, stapling of a head laceration, and OG tube placement under the direct supervision of the preceptor. Updated family members on the status of their loved ones. Presented a case involving MDMA toxicity at a Mass General Brigham medical management conference.

• Saw obstetric patients in the Women's Evaluation and Treatment Unit, analyzing non-stress tests and deciding whether admission to the labor and delivery unit was warranted. Assisted in vaginal deliveries, mostly with delivery and inspection of the placenta, and postpartum fundal massage on the night Labor and Delivery unit. Observed the entire algorithm for postpartum hemorrhage be carried out, from fundal massage to Bakri balloon placement. Scrubbed into several C-sections. Saw obstetric and gynecologic patients in the Northampton clinic. Used doppler ultrasound to listen to fetal heart tones during prenatal visits. Performed pelvic exams - bimanual and speculum exams. Obtained pap smears +/- HPV testing. Observed IUD and Nexplanon removal and replacements, colposcopies, and an endometrial biopsy. Wrote annual and office visit gynecologic notes.

• Provided cross coverage at night. This included doing admissions and responding to nursing and rapid response pages. Participated in many admission calls with ED providers. Assumed care and quickly intervened during rapid responses under the supervision of my preceptor. Wrote cross cover notes on paged rapid responses. Performed CPR during cardiac arrests. Carried out ABGs. Reviewed EKGs and imaging. Observed a bedside surgical cricothyrotomy. Pronounced death and wrote death certificates.
