Clinical Innovations

Revised Clinical Documentation Forest Hills Hospital Due to a decrease in appropriate documentation regarding prophylaxis for thrombotic events, I revised the HPI (History of Present Illness) documentation utilized by residents when admitted patients. This revision included details of what kind of prophylaxis the patient may need during their hospital stay.
