



Intro Screens




- As the user enters the app, they should go directly into Viewing Posts (thread).
- 2. Bold "KOLLECTIVMEDIA"
- Right align "a product of KingT Stu dios-HDM, LLC" to the last letter of "KOLLECTIVMEDIA", lowercase "a"
- 4. Remove "User Name" area
- 5. 3-smaller buttonsbottom of screen
 - a. "Profile" (left)
 - b. "Upload" (center)
 - c. "Search" (right)
- 6. Bring background (featured) image forward, decrease o pacity slightly
- Remove Title/Ad Region background, float "KOLLECTIVMEDIA" on top of scrolling thread
- 8. Increase opacity of 3-buttons (above); make float on top of image
- Scroll affect of thread, with 3buttons floating


Upgrade/Options Hover Screen

- 2. "Thank you for upgrading your account."
- 3. Buttons:
 - a. Cancel (left)
 - b. Upgrade
- 4. New Upgrade Screen
 - a. Reuse existing App button look & feel

Upload Fly-In Screen



- 1. Decrease fly-in size by half
- 2. Decrease font 3pts
- 3. Buttons (5):
 - a. "Take Photo From Camera"
 - b. "Upload Photo From Library"
 - c. "Upload Video From Library"
 - d. "Direct & Shoot Live Video"
 - e. Cancel

*"Direct & Shoot Live Video"

allows user to shoot & post vide o directly on the fly, without uploading later.

- Add Social Media
 Icons/Links at bottom on

- 2. New-Add Button: "Add to Group"
- 3. Display Views
- 4. Display List of Comments
- Display # of groups User is in, call this link/icon "Groupies"
 - a. Clicking Groupies will list all of the "Group Names" the user is in.
