Ms. Pollard is seeking full-time positions working, ideally, 3 – 12 hour shifts per week. She is open to working 4 – 10s as well, however. Either way, she is looking to avoid the 5-day work week if at all possible. She hopes to relocate to the New York City area around September and is looking for a psychiatry position where she sees less severe psychiatric cases and where she can dedicate the appropriate amount of time to her patients. She notes that seeing more than 3 patients per hour would be too much as she would not be able to give the time and attention needed to adequately address patient's needs.

Ms. Pollard submits that she is a hard worker and describes herself as diligent and efficient. She also submits that she is good with patients and that she will go above and beyond when needed. She is ready to begin interviewing and discussing any relevant opportunities. At this time, she welcomes contact through phone call or email.
