- My main role is a provider in clinic seeing patients preoperatively, postoperatively, and treating a diverse patient population of varying complaints and severity. A smaller but important role consists of inpatient rounding and seeing patients in the hospital and ER on-call
- Ordering and interpreting labs and imaging as well as detailed documentation are a daily responsibility
- Common conditions I diagnose and treat include: acute, chronic, and interstitial cystitis; prostatitis; pyelonephritis; epididymitis/orchitis; balanitis; urethritis, phimosis; paraphimosis; Peyronies; meatal stenosis; urethral stricture; BPH; ED; hydrocele; varicocele; hematospermia, hematuria, hypogonadism, infertility, incontinence; urine retention; hernias; urolithiasis; dysuria; enuresis; hydronephrosis; pelvic floor dysfunction; vaginal atrophy; elevated PSA
- Cancers I manage and follow are testicular, prostate, bladder, and kidney.
- One day a week is dedicated to the OR. I act as first assist for many cases and input surgical pre op, post op, and discharge orders
- Common intraoperative cases include: orchiectomy; orchiopexy, varicocelectomy; inguinal hernia repair; hydrocelectomy; TURP; TURBT; ureteroscopy with stone extraction; ureteral stents; lithotripsy; urethral sling; bladder hydrodistention; DVIU; circumcision; interstim; litholapaxy; suprapubic tube placement; Urolift
- Procedures and diagnostics I perform in office include: bladder scan; bladder lavage; foley and intermittent catheterization; voiding trials; medicine injections; bladder instillations; hydrocele aspiration and sclerotherapy; Select MDx; urethral dilation
