- Work with a large team of interventional cardiologists and PAs to manage patients pre and post cardiac/peripheral catheterization and on a telemetry floor utilizing the Epic EMR system
- Care for patients with variety of acute and chronic cardiac/non-cardiac conditions (eg. ACS, heart failure, valvular disease, cardiomyopathies, conduction disorders, congenital heart disease and peripheral vascular disease)
- Manage patients pre-catheterization with duties including obtaining HPI, patient evaluation/physical exam, obtaining consent, review labs/imaging/EKG to determine possible contraindications to catheterization
- Manage patients post catheterization with duties including order entry, physical examination, femoral venous and arterial sheath pulls, radial access management and management of various post catheterization complications including arterial and venous bleeding, hematoma, AV fistula, pseudoaneurysm, vasovagal reaction, cardiac arrhythmias, recognition of stroke and retroperitoneal bleeding)
- Serve as Charge PA with duties including triaging inpatients for catheterization, triaging patients for admission to telemetry floor, managing bed flow within the cath lab and on telemetry floor
