OU Health Physicians Bedlam Clinic (Tulsa, Oklahoma)

- Served as primary care provider in a biweekly clinic for a panel of uninsured Tulsa patients.
- Worked in collaboration with OU pharmacy, social work, and nursing to manage chronic conditions.
- Clinic visits included rooming patients, gathering vital signs, obtaining full histories, performing complete physical exams, creating a well-rounded plan, and documenting a comprehensive visit note.
- Visits commonly included ordering and reviewing laboratory tests, completing in-office A1C tests, well-woman examinations, diabetic foot exams, placing referrals, and completing in-office EKG's.
